2. Abstracts submitted outside the theme listed may please state a new theme proposed for consideration.
3. Abstracts will be evaluated with respect to originality, significance, and relevance to conference title. Acceptance/non-acceptance will be notified according to prescribed date.
4. Deadline of submission of Abstract: **25th May 2010**

The Conference's official language is English. All submissions must be in the prescribed language. No translation will be provided.

4. Single-spaced using Arial type font (12 pts).
5. Formattable copy (preferably in Word File format) and submitted as Attachment to email.
